What does Stride Funding Inc. Do with Your Personal Information?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Social Security number and income</li><li>■ Account balances, payment and transaction history</li><li>■ Credit history and credit scores</li><li>■ Name, address, email address and phone number</li></ul> <p>If you are a new customer, we can begin sharing your information 30 days from the date of this notice. When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Stride chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Stride Funding Inc., "Stride"
What we do	
How does Stride protect my personal information?	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>Stride's policy is such that access to confidential information is provided only to those employees who need to know such information to administer your account(s).</p>
How does Stride collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Apply for a financial product</li><li>• Update information or request any changes to your financial product</li></ul> <p>Give us your contact information, employment history or income information</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Make payments toward your financial product</li></ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li><li>■ affiliates from using your information to market to you</li><li>■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li></ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Stride Fund 1 LLC</li><li>■ Outcomes-Based Financing LLC</li><li>■ Affiliates exclude any other portfolio company of venture capital investors owning less than 50% of Stride Funding Inc.</li></ul>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Specific nonaffiliates include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ FinWise Bank</li><li>■ Origination platform partners (inclusive of GDS Link and CampusDoor Holdings)</li><li>■ Student loan and consumer loan servicers (inclusive of Launch Servicing, Knowledge Finance, MOHELA, and Meratas)</li><li>■ Credit reporting agencies (inclusive of TransUnion)</li><li>■ Schools with whom we have commercial relationships</li></ul>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p>Our only joint marketing partner is FinWise Bank.</p>

State Laws	<p>Depending upon where you live, you may have additional privacy protections under some state laws. We comply with applicable state laws before sharing non-public information about you.</p>
